HOW TO FORM A TEAM:

If you are a Parent (if you are already a G.A.C coach, skip step #1):

Step #1. Find/Ask a current coach that is willing coach the team through the spring

Step #2. Find/Ask the number of players required that are willing to play

U-6 to U-8 9-11 Players per team

U-9 to U-11 11-13 Players per team

U-12 14-16 Players per team

Step #3. E-mail Scott Hyams with your team roster and coach's name:

Step #4. You will be provided registration forms to complete and return to G.A.C.

F.A.Q.

- 1. Can I register individually for the Spring Program?**
 - a. No. Players must register as part of a team. The Technical Director will keep a list of players looking for a team to participate with, however, this does not guarantee a spot in the spring program.
- 2. Why does my team have to register with the Pacific Eagles?**
 - a. To play in the USSL our teams must be registered with a USSL sanctioned club. Our teams play in the league through the Pacific Eagles but train as part of Guildford Athletic Club. The spring program is a G.A.C. endorsed program.
- 3. Can I register with another summer club other than the Pacific Eagles?**
 - a. Yes, but only if you have played for another summer club in the past. All new teams will be channeled through the Pacific Eagles. If you would like to register through another summer club, please contact Scott Hyams at: tmini@guildfordac.com
- 4. When will my team train?**
 - a. The training schedule will be created on a first come first served basis. The first teams to register will get to select their training slot first.
- 5. What are the training slots?**
 - a. Training times depend on field allocations from the city of Surrey. Anticipated training times available will be Monday to Friday, 5:00pm – 6:30pm or 6:30pm – 8:00pm in the Guildford area.
- 6. On what day are the league games?**
 - a. All games are played on Sundays at Surrey and Langley parks.
- 7. What is the U.S.S.L.?**
 - a. The USSL is a summer league where teams are tiered based on their level of play. The focus of the league is fun and fair play.
